Black Belt in California!

After 6 years of training I will be testing for Black Belt in Japanese Karate-Do! I am honored to be a Black Belt under Sensei Demura. Sensei only tests for Black Belt once a year, and you have to go to California to test. They don't tell you if you pass right away, you have to wait for the results. If you pass you will receive a probationary Black Belt. Then within the next year if you do well you will be awarded your "name" belt, and receive a certificate! We will have to be closed while I am gone.
